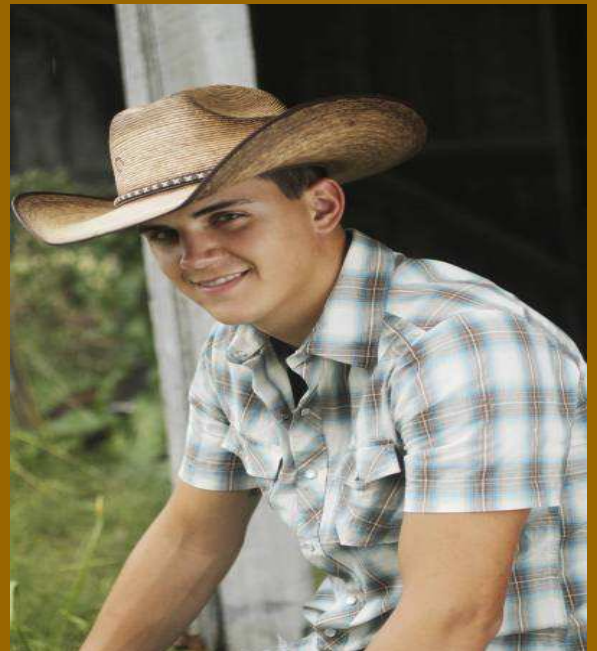

5 Holers: Typically golfers 9-11 years old or golfers who average 12 or better on a par 4 and can walk 5 holes

9 Holers: Typically golfers 12-16 years old or golfers who average 9 or better on a par 4 and can walk 9 holes

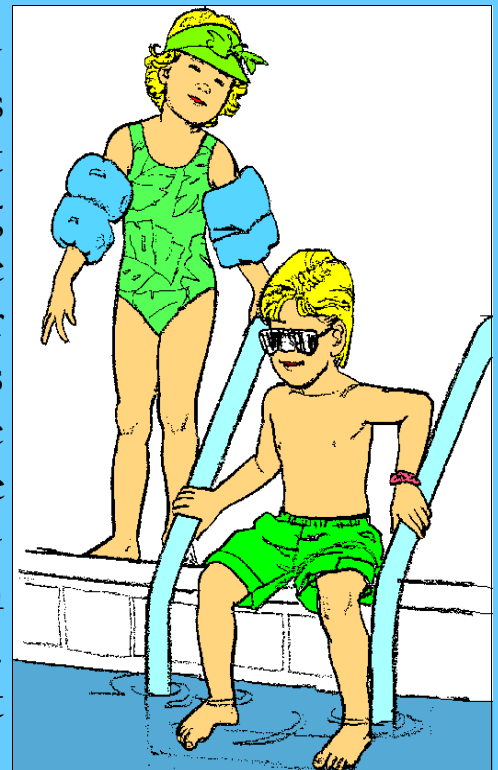
TENNIS AT THE OTTUMWA COUNTRY CLUB

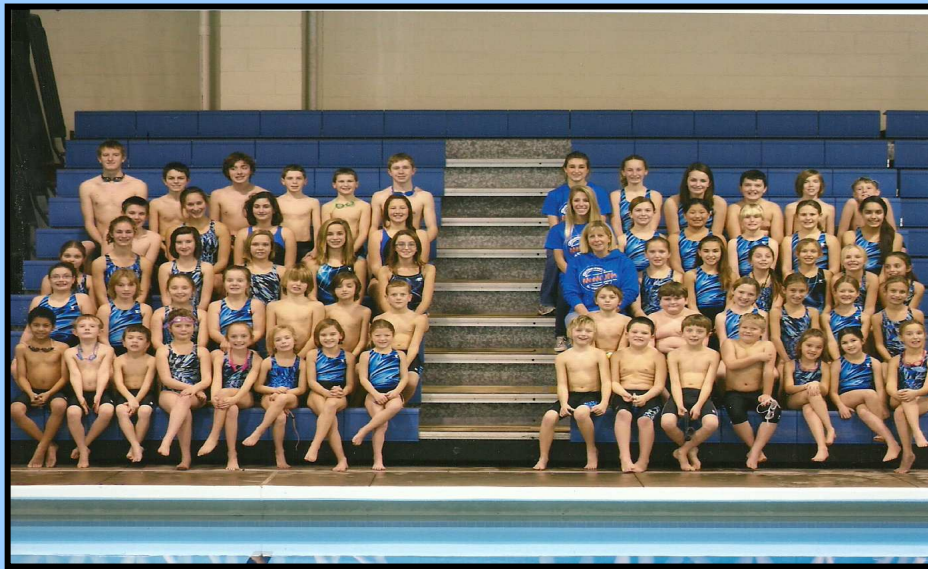


Swimming Lessons at OCC
